

Operatoren Englisch 2007

Es wird drei Aufgabenblöcke geben: Im ersten steht der Anforderungsbereich I im Mittelpunkt, im zweiten der Anforderungsbereich II, im dritten Teil stehen Anforderungsbereiche II und III im Mittelpunkt. Die Arbeitsaufträge werden mittels folgender Operatoren gestellt werden, wobei ein Arbeitsauftrag auch mehrere Operatoren, gegebenenfalls auch weitere Arbeitshinweise, enthalten kann. Die jeweiligen Anforderungsbereiche stehen in Klammern. Für kreative Aufgabenstellungen wird zumeist nicht auf die Liste der Operatoren zurückgegriffen, sondern es werden jeweils genaue Anforderungen formuliert.

Der Begriff ‚Text‘ bezieht sich auf den erweiterten Textbegriff. Hierzu zählen z.B. auch Statistiken und Bilder.

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Aufgabenblock I		
give an account of / outline (I)	<i>Give the main features, structure or general principles of a topic omitting minor details. Do not give your own opinion or interpretation.</i>	<i>Give an account of/ Outline the conversation between the mother and her teenage daughter.</i>
describe (I)		<i>Describe the living conditions in 2054 as depicted in the text.</i>
summarize (I) sum up (I)		<i>Summarize/sum up the information given in the text in no more than words.</i>

Aufgabenblock II		
show / point out how ... (II)	<i>Name and interpret specific aspects and/or features of the text and their effect on the audience.</i>	<i>Show how atmosphere is created.</i>
describe the way / the means through which ... (II)		<i>Describe the way the playwright creates an atmosphere of suspense.</i>
analyze (II)		<i>Analyze the structural and/or stylistic devices used by the author and their effect on the readership.</i>
compare (II)	<i>point out similarities and differences</i>	<i>Compare the graph and the text.</i>

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Aufgabenblock III		
explain (II)	describe in detail and give reasons for	Explain the protagonist's obsession with power.
contrast (II)	emphasize the differences between two or more things	Contrast the author's idea of human aggression with the theories of aggression you have read about.
discuss / comment on (III)	write about a subject by carefully presenting various points with supporting evidence and conclude with your personal view	Comment on the protagonist's view of marriage and compare it to that of the nurse in <i>Romeo and Juliet</i> . Discuss the different attitudes towards marriage as presented in the text.
suggest solutions (III)	propose ideas to solve a problem	Suggest solutions to the problem.
convince (III)	present arguments so that the addressee will support your view	Convince a friend that your views are right.
evaluate / assess (III)	decide on the value or the state of something and give reasons for your decision	Evaluate the steps that have been taken to improve the situation of children.
give your opinion / what do you think (III)	express your personal view on certain behavior, attitudes or viewpoints and give reasons	Give your opinion on the main character's way of coping with his wife's death.
consider pros and cons (III)	look at advantages and disadvantages of a view or an attitude and draw a conclusion	Consider the pros and cons of TV as presented in the text.
